

## A French camp with a family atmosphere!

Give your children the opportunity to speak French and make new friends during the holidays!

The Lycée Français de Toronto (LFT) contributes to the educational and cultural enrichment of the Toronto community by fostering awareness and knowledge of the French culture and the French language.

The LFT belongs to a network of 400 French schools around the world and welcomes children from age 2 and a half to University entrance. In the graduating year called Terminale, students will take the French Baccalaureate, a challenging diploma, which opens doors to the best universities in North America and Europe.



During the school breaks, the Lycée Français de Toronto opens its doors to children 4 to 13 years of age, offering them a unique opportunity to enjoy their holidays in French. Children currently registered in Early Pre- Kindergarten at the Lycée are also welcome.

Our Camp supervisors, teachers and educational assistants at the Lycée, will be ensuring every effort is made to create a fun and educational environment. The children's ratio is 10:1.

Participants will enjoy a friendly atmosphere and live each week **a new French experience**. They will be able to develop their language skills through a variety of well balanced indoor and outdoor activities such as sports, games, cultural activities, arts, crafts, and cooking.

In the course of a typical day, children will participate in sports and games in the morning and art and recreational games in the afternoon. Sports activities are led by **Katya for fencing** and **Guy for sports**. Our youngest campers (3 to 6 year olds) will only participate in introductory fencing sessions but will enjoy a daily yoga class with Corentine.



Learning through sports and play develops life skills that are universal and transferable to everyday life. In the spirit of Pierre de Coubertin's famous quote "the important thing in life is not to triumph but to compete", we encourage children to participate fully in all the daily activities.

For some activities, sports in particular, campers will be divided according to their age. Otherwise, they will participate together in various workshops like **cooking with H el ene**, **arts and crafts with Corentine** and other recreational and cultural activities in which each one of them will play and learn in French!



Camps run from Monday through Friday, from 9:30 am to 4:30 pm. The Lyc ee offers free daycare for families who wish to drop their children off at 8:30 a.m. and pick them up at 5:30 p.m.

In the spirit of the holidays and to give everyone in the family a rest, snacks and lunches are prepared at the Lyc ee by an experienced cook and provided to the children free of charge. Meals are nutritious and well balanced. Food allergies are taken into consideration. A nut-free environment is enforced. Just like at home, campers and staff share their meals and snacks around the same table! Lunch is a time where everyone enjoys a delicious meal in a relaxed atmosphere. Children are encouraged to try various types of foods and proper table manners are emphasized.

Our goal is to offer your children a warm and stimulating environment while giving them the opportunity to learn French in a fun and creative atmosphere.

At the end of each session, children will have made new friends and enriched their French vocabulary. They will also be proud to bring home their activity books. This camp with a French touch will help them develop strong friendships they can reinforce and renew every time they come back to the LFT.
