

# 2010-2011 Financial Regulations

## 1. Methods of Payment

A) **By cheque payable to « Lycée Français de Toronto »**

## 2. Tuition Fees (All amounts are in Canadian dollars)

**Tuition fees cover instruction in the basic school programs and do not include books, exam fees, after school programs, trips, athletics, transportation or meals.**

## 3. Payment Options

**PLAN A- one LUMP SUM payment made on or before April 15, 2010**

**PLAN C- 12 monthly payments starting on April 15, 2010 until March 15, 2011, for an amount of:**

### Reduction in fees

When three or more siblings attend the LFT, a **25% reduction** in tuition is granted to the **third** child, and any further children. This reduction applies to the youngest child.

#### 4. Daycare and Study Hall Fees 2010-11

Payment options:

**A) 10% discount** applies to those who pay in one lump sum **before September 30, 2010**

**B) Three equal payments** made on or before September 30, 2010, January 15, and April 15, 2011.

Exceptional daycare: \$12 per hour

Exceptional Study hall: \$18 per hour

Late penalties: \$1 per minute, applicable immediately after 4.30 or 6.00 pm pick up

#### 5. Transportation Fees 2010-11

Downtown Bus (Intersection of Bay and St Joseph): \$ 600 per year

Shuttle (St Clair West subway station): \$ 250 per year

#### 6. New Registration

Each application must be received with a non refundable fee of \$200.

Once the student is accepted, a \$2,000 refundable deposit (refer to paragraph 12) plus the tuition fees must be paid.

#### Spot reservation for a student living abroad at the time of registration

To reserve a spot payment of Can\$4,000 is required. Payments will be adjusted upon the student's arrival at the Lycée. A 10% cancellation fee applies.

#### Registration during the school year

Tuition fees for students registering during the school year are **prorated** according to **Plan B** of the financial regulations. Every month attended is payable in full.

#### 7. Payment Options for Students receiving a bursary from the French Government

To apply for financial support, students must be registered at the Consulate General of France in Toronto. They must also meet the criteria set by the *commission nationale des bourses*.

For new applicants, a \$200 non refundable application fee and a \$2,000 refundable deposit are payable upon registration.

Once the student's admission is confirmed, \$300 per month per application are payable starting April 15, 2010 until the official bursary notification is received. Payments will then be adjusted accordingly. In the event of the bursary application being rejected, full tuition according to **Plan A** is to be paid.

Should the parent decide not to enroll the child at the school, all amounts will be reimbursed.

**Parents already receiving a bursary** from the French Government in 2009/2010 will follow the same financial arrangements for the 2010/2011 school year. Payments will be adjusted accordingly when the official bursary notification is received.

## 8. Payment Options for Students in Grade 10, 11 or 12 and Receiving a Grant from the French Government

To qualify for this grant, a student must be registered at the Consulate General of France in Toronto and reside with his parents. An application must be filed and remitted to the school by the date set by the French Consulate. Parents must verify their eligibility by contacting the French Consulate ([christine.bertrand@diplomatie.gouv.fr](mailto:christine.bertrand@diplomatie.gouv.fr) or 416 847 1886).

A \$200 non refundable application fee and a \$2,000 refundable deposit are payable upon registration. As of April 15, 2010, a payment of \$300 per month is required for each student benefiting from this grant until the official notification from the *commission nationale des bourses* is received. In the event of the grant application being rejected, full tuition according to **Plan A** is to be paid.

## 9. Exam Fees

Exam fees for grades 9, 11 and 12 students vary each year and will be requested for exam registration.

## 10. Payment Obligations and Penalties

**Attendance of a student at the Lycée implies the acceptance of the Financial Regulations.**

Please note that all cheques will be deposited on the date of the cheque.

A **\$50** fee will be charged for every declined cheque. Once a cheque is declined, the school will only accept certified cheques or wire transfer for future payments.

Students whose parents have not fulfilled their financial obligations by September 1, 2010 will not be allowed in class on the first day of school.

Students whose parents have not fulfilled their financial obligations by December 1<sup>st</sup>, 2010 will not be allowed in class as of January 1<sup>st</sup>, 2011.

Students whose parents have not fulfilled their financial obligations by March 1<sup>st</sup>, 2011 will not be allowed in class as of April 1<sup>st</sup>, 2011.

**Eviction of a student from the Lycée does not alter the financial obligations towards the Lycée. The Lycée will not negotiate any partial payment for outstanding amounts.**

## 11. Early Withdrawal

Parents withdrawing their child from the Lycée Français de Toronto will have to **inform the Principal**, Dominique Duthel, **in writing** ([proviseur@lft.ca](mailto:proviseur@lft.ca)) and they will pay tuition according to the schedule below:

Notice of Withdrawal Received	Percentage of Non Refundable Fees
Before August 31, 2010	10% of the full year's tuition
From September 1 <sup>st</sup> to December 31 <sup>st</sup> , 2010	50% of the full year's tuition
After December 31 <sup>st</sup> , 2010	100% of the full year's tuition

Refunds will be issued to the person who has made the original payment.

## 12. Refundable Deposit

This is a non interest bearing deposit which will be refunded to the payee by July 2011 net of all outstanding amounts due to the school. If a student withdraws before January 1st, 2011 this refund will be issued within 2 months following his withdrawal. In the event that the Lycée is unable to locate the payee within two years of the student's departure, the deposit will belong to the Lycée.

## 13. Visiting Students

Pending the Principal's approval, the Lycée is happy to welcome alumni and friends of students currently registered at the school. Visits exceeding one day will be billed at a rate of \$60 per day.
