

## *Financial regulation for the academic year* 2022-2023

### Schedule of Fees

---

#### **New enrollment**

- Application Fee : \$300
  
- To confirm enrollment :
- Admission Fee : \$350
- One-time enrollment Fee : \$3 500

#### **Re-enrollment**

- Annual Contribution to the Capital Investment Fund \$400 (except Grade 1).
- One time enrollment fee for Grade 1 \$3 500 (if not paid in previous school years)

#### **Tuition Fees (for all students).**

- Pre-K to Grade 5      \$19 200
- Grades 6 to 9        \$20 500
- Grades 10 to 12     \$21 700

Tuition includes \$25 of registration to APA (LFT Parents association).

Tuition does not include exam fees, after school programs, trips, transportation, textbooks or meals.

#### **Additional Fee**

- Pre-K /TPS-PS : mandatory fee for snack and lunch program : \$2 500

## Reduction in Tuition Fees

3rd child : 10% reduction tuition

4th child : 15% reduction on tuition

## Single Payment

A rebate of \$500 is applicable to tuition payments received in full before April 15, 2022. This is applicable only to students who have not availed of any other rebate.

## Enrollment

---

1. Full year enrollment

### New enrollment

To secure a spot \$5,650 is due upon enrollment. This amount consists of \$1,800 (non-refundable) advance on tuition, \$350 admission fee, together with \$3,500 (one time enrollment fee). This amount will be deducted from the total invoice due to the school. The balance is due in one, four or twelve equal payments depending on the payment plan you select.

### Re-enrollment

To secure a spot, \$2,200 is due upon enrollment. This amount consists of a \$1,800 (non-refundable) advance on tuition and a \$400 annual capital contribution. This amount will be deducted from the total invoice due to the school. The balance is due in one, four or twelve equal payments depending on the payment plan you select. Returning senior kindergarten students enrolling into grade 1 must pay a one-time enrollment fee of \$3,500 upon re-enrollment (if not paid in previous school years).

2. New enrollment during the school year

Tuition is prorated on a monthly basis with 50% of the tuition amount due before or on the first day of class and the balance by March 15, 2023. Every month attended is payable in full.

## Refund Policy

---

Notice of withdrawal must be sent in writing to the Admissions Office at [admissions@lft.ca](mailto:admissions@lft.ca).

### Non refundable ::

- Application Fee : \$300
- Admission Fee : \$350
- Annual Capital Contribution : \$400
- Advance on Tuition : \$1 800
- The one time enrollment fee (\$3,500) is not refundable after September 1st, 2022

### Tuition paid is refundable, consistent with the following schedule :

- If a student withdraws before May 31st, 2022 : the \$1800 paid on enrollment will not be refunded, the balance of the annual tuition paid will be refunded.

- If a student withdraws between June 1st and July 31st, 2022 : 25% of the annual tuition is fully due and the balance if paid is refundable. If 25% of the tuition has not been paid at the time of the withdrawal, the balance is due on departure.
- If a student withdraws between August 1st and Dec 31st, 2022, 75% of the annual tuition is fully due. If 75% of the tuition has not been paid at the time of the withdrawal, the balance is due on the date of departure.
- No refunds for withdrawals after January 1, 2023
- If enrollment is cancelled before or during the school year, the single payment rebate will not be applicable.

## Financial Aid

---

### **Families have to be in good financial standing with LFT to be eligible to apply for financial aid.**

- **FRENCH BURSARY**  
French nationals who apply to the LFT and are registered at the Consulate General of France in Toronto may apply for financial assistance provided they meet the criteria set by the commission nationale des bourses (<https://toronto.consulfrance.org>). Deadline to receive the application is set by the French Consulate
- **LFT BURSARY**  
LFT re-enrolling students from Grade 1 to Grade 12 may apply for financial assistance at <https://applefinancialservices.ca/>. Deadline to receive applications: March 15 2022. Decisions will be communicated by LFT bursary committee in June 2022.
- Should the parent proceed with the enrollment, the difference between tuition due and LFT bursary received is to be paid according to LFT payment schedule.

### **If the bursary application is rejected :**

- Should the parent proceed with the enrollment, full tuition is due as per the quarterly or monthly payment plan.
- Should the parent decide not to enroll their child, the refund policy will be applied.
- In case of partial attendance, fees are prorated as per section 3 above.

## Payment plan and method of payment

---

Payments can be made by wire or pre-authorized debit (PAD). Payment plans are: 1 payment, 4 payments or 12 payments (at an additional cost of \$300).

Please note that payments by wire transfer must include an additional \$20 to cover fees charged to LFT by the bank for this type of payment.

### **New enrollment:**

- PAD forms and a VOID cheque must be sent to the admissions office on enrollment.
- Wires must be sent before April 15, 2022 in accordance with the selected payment plan and include the additional \$20 mentioned above.

### **Re-enrollment:**

- LFT will use your existing banking information. If this has changed, please update your information with the accounting office at [finance@lft.ca](mailto:finance@lft.ca).
- Wires must be sent before April 15, 2022 in accordance with the selected payment plan.

### **Obligations and penalties**

- Families' must be in good standing to re-enroll their child(ren)
- 50% of tuition must be paid before the 1st day of school.
- 75% of tuition must be paid before December 15, 2022
- Tuition must be paid in full by March 15, 2023
- A \$50 fee will be charged for every declined payment.
- \$500 will be charged to all accounts that remain in arrears as of March 15, 2023.
- Delayed payments may lead to penalties up to expulsion of the student(s) from LFT.
- Eviction of a student does not alter his/her financial obligations towards LFT.
- LFT will not negotiate any partial payment for outstanding amounts.

## Receipts

---

A portion of the tuition paid may qualify as a child care expense receipt. This eligible amount is calculated based on the Canada Revenue Agency regulations. Receipts are issued in February, following the close of the previous calendar year.
