Position overview

This position is under the functional authority of the director of secondary school. The English teacher acts in compliance with the operating rules of a French institution while respecting Ontario regulations.

The English curriculum at LFT follows the French national programs based on the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR)

The position is located at the Lycée Français de Toronto, 2327 Dufferin St in Toronto.

Missions

The teacher will:

- Teach the English curriculum according to the grade and language levels assigned (ESL/ADV) from Gr.6 to 12
- Use a variety of pedagogical teaching strategies as outlined in the OCT Standards of Practice
- Evaluate and grade students' acquired skill (class work, projects, assignments, etc)
- Plan and use appropriate instructional strategies, activities, materials, and equipment to accommodate students with special educational needs
- Prepare students for the French national exams (DNB/DNBI in Gr. 9 and *baccalauréat* in Gr. 12)
- Work collaboratively with the English department and teachers from other subjects regarding evaluation practices, curriculum/program development, as well as interdisciplinary projects
- Maintain contact and dialogue with families regarding students work, results and progress
- Participate in departmental and staff meetings, class councils, parent-teachers meetings, etc.

Qualifications and requirements

- OCT certified (English and ESL - Intermediate and Senior divisions) or international equivalent and/or
- Teaching experience (5+ years) and/or
- Experience in an AEFE / MLF school

Contract

- Contract would be under our local staff's collective agreement which includes benefits.
- Various positions from 10 to 20 hrs/week (18hrs+ is a full time position) according to the LFT academic calendar.
