Engage and inspire the desire to learn

In the French teaching and learning model, there are 4 grades in the kindergarten cycle:

- the *Toute Petite Section* and *Petite Section* (TPS/PS) correspond to Pre-Kindergarten (from 2.5 years old)
- *Moyenne Section* (MS) corresponds to Junior Kindergarten (4 years old)
- *Grande Section* (GS) corresponds to Senior Kindergarten (5 years old)

Kindergarten covers the 5 fundamental learning areas for the development and success of children.

Children will learn and live together: understand the purpose of the school, develop themselves as a unique individual within a group.



Our educational approach engages each child to have confidence in his or her own ability to act and think, to learn and to succeed.

The aim of this program is to inspire children, to encourage them to learn and to develop their personalities.

Canada-wide Early Learning and Child Care

LFT is part of the Canada-Wide Early Learning & Child Care program (CWELCC), a federal initiative to facilitate access to quality child care for Ontario families by making it more affordable and inclusive.

Tuition fees for students enrolled in Pre-Kindergarten are subsidized by the Ontario government at a rate of 52.75%.

Why did the LFT choose to join the CWELCC program?

We believe in and advocate for an inclusive vision of education at the LFT.

Which classes are covered by the program?

The classes of *Toute Petite Section* (TPS) and *Petite Section* (PS), i.e., students aged 2.5 to 4 years old, are covered by the CWELCC program.

What are the benefits for my child?

Rather than joining a day care, TPS/PS students at LFT benefit from French educational excellence through a balanced curriculum in two languages. Children are prepared to continue their education in French and/or English.
